We will continue to emphasize the importance of making responsible choices, treating others with respect, and resolving conflicts peacefully. Our counseling team is available to provide support and guidance to any students who may be struggling with conflict resolution or other challenges.

Furthermore, we urge parents and guardians to have open and honest conversations with their children about the consequences of their actions, both on and off school grounds. Reinforcing our school values and expectations at home is crucial in promoting positive behavior and preventing future incidents.
