These efforts are further reinforced through Ilima's family-centered events: such as Open House & Title I Night, Ilima Family Nites, curriculum-focused showcases, and student recognition celebrations, which provide opportunities for teachers and families to connect, share strategies for supporting student learning, and collaborate around student success. Through these actions, Ilima Intermediate ensures that all families are valued as essential partners in the education of their children and that staff are fully prepared to foster strong, respectful, and productive relationships with our school community.
