

- FERPA <u>protects</u> the privacy of students by restricting access to records that contain Personally Identifiable Information (PII).
- FERPA <u>does not permit</u> the disclosure of PII from education records without consent, except under certain *Exceptions*.
- FERPA <u>requires</u> that *Reasonable Methods* be used to protect the integrity and security of the data being maintained at the school or district.
- FERPA <u>does permit</u> the disclosure of certain types of PII that is previously designated as *Directory Information* by the school or district.
- FERPA affords parents and eligible students the right to have access to their children's education records, and the right to seek to have the records amended.
